**Danica Patrick on the PEAK Antifreeze & Motor Oil Indy Grand Prix:**

“Infineon is always a track that I enjoy racing at. The Motorola car sat on the front row last year which was definitely a highlight of the weekend. The most important thing about road courses is your track position, so hopefully we will have a strong qualifying run.”

**Danica Patrick Facts**

- This is Patrick’s fourth start at Infineon Raceway.
- Patrick sat on the front row in 2007.
- Patrick’s best finish at Infineon Raceway was sixth in 2007.
- Patrick won her first IndyCar Series race in 2008 at the Indy Japan 300.
- Patrick is currently sixth in the IndyCar Series championship.
- She finished seventh in the 2007 IndyCar Series standings.
- Patrick had four top-five and 11 top-10 finishes in her first year of driving for Andretti Green Racing, including finishes of third at Texas and Nashville, and a fifth-place finish at Mid-Ohio.
- In 2005, she won the Bombardier Learjet Rookie of the Year award after finishing 12<sup>th</sup> in the final standings, recording two top fives and seven top 10s, including a fourth in the Indianapolis 500®.
- Patrick is one of only 18 drivers in IndyCar Series history to earn three pole positions, those coming at Kansas Speedway, Kentucky Speedway and Chicagoland Speedway in her rookie season.

**Marco Andretti on the PEAK Antifreeze & Motor Oil Indy Grand Prix:**

"I enjoy coming back to Infineon because it is a track where I have a really high level of confidence. I have a good feel for the track and have turned a ton of laps there in many different formulas. Thankfully we've had a lot of success in the past. Andretti Green always gives us good race cars there and I think the Blockbuster/STAR WARS: THE CLONE WARS car will contend for a victory, for sure."

**Marco Andretti Facts**

- This is Andretti's third start at Infineon Raceway. He recorded his first IndyCar Series victory at Infineon in 2006 after starting second.
- At the 2007 event, Andretti was involved in an accident while competing for the lead.
- He started from the pole, led every lap and won the 2005 Firestone Indy Lights race at Infineon.
- He is seventh in the IndyCar Series championship, only four points out of sixth place.
- He has led more laps in 2008 than in 2006 and 2007 combined. His 330 laps led rank fourth in 2008.
- Andretti finished third at the 2008 Indianapolis 500®. He has a second-place and a third-place finish at Indianapolis in three career starts.
- In his rookie season, Andretti finished second at the 2006 Indianapolis 500 in what was the second-closest finish in the history of the event.
- He joined both his father and grandfather in earning the Indianapolis 500 Rookie of the Year honor.
- In 2006, Andretti became the youngest driver (19 years, five months, 14 days) at the time to win a major open-wheel race when he took the checkered flag at Infineon Raceway.
- He made six starts in the Firestone Indy Lights in 2005, collecting three victories (St. Petersburg, Indianapolis road course and Infineon Raceway), five top fives and three pole positions.

#### Hideki Mutoh on the Peak Antifreeze & Motor Oil Indy Grand Prix:

“I haven’t been pleased with the past couple of races, so I hope I will be able to do well this weekend. It was nice to have a week off to refresh my mind. Infineon Raceway is a beautiful track and the course is very fun to drive.”

#### Hideki Mutoh Facts

- This is Mutoh’s first career IndyCar Series start at Infineon.
- Mutoh has two starts at Infineon Raceway in the Firestone Indy Lights series.
- Mutoh had a career-best finish of second at Iowa Speedway, which is the best result for a Japanese driver in IndyCar Series history.
- He has seven top-10 finishes in the 14 races this season and eight top 10s in his 15 career starts.
- Mutoh scored a seventh-place finish at the 92<sup>nd</sup> running of the Indianapolis 500 after qualifying a rookie-best ninth.
- This is Mutoh’s 16<sup>th</sup> IndyCar Series race start – 15 of which have come this season with Andretti Green Racing. His debut was at Chicagoland Speedway in 2007.
- He finished second in the 2007 Firestone Indy Lights championship, earning the Lucas Oil Rookie of the Year award.
- He recorded 10 top-five finishes in Firestone Indy Lights in 2007, including victories at Indianapolis (road course) and Kentucky.
- In 2007, Mutoh tied for first among all Firestone Indy Lights drivers with 13 top-10 finishes.

#### Tony Kanaan on the PEAK Antifreeze & Motor Oil Indy Grand Prix:

"I always really enjoy racing at Infineon. The Team 7-Eleven car is always competitive and AGR has had a lot of success at the track in the past. It would be a big boost to the team if we could win a couple more races before the season ends so we'll be pushing for the front."

#### Tony Kanaan Facts

- This is Kanaan's fourth start at Infineon. He won the inaugural IndyCar Series event at Infineon in 2005 after starting third. He started third and finished fourth in 2007.
- Kanaan has qualified for the Firestone Fast Six shootout at the three previous Infineon races.
- He has one victory in 2008. He started on the pole position and won at Richmond.
- He has 13 career IndyCar Series victories and 14 major open-wheel racing wins in his career.
- Kanaan is in fourth place in the IndyCar Series championship, only nine points out of third.
- Kanaan has led 367 laps in 2008. That is the third-highest total in the IndyCar Series.
- He is the only driver in history to lead laps in his first seven starts in the Indianapolis 500® (2002-2008) and the only driver in history to lead laps in seven-consecutive Indianapolis 500 races.
- Kanaan won the IndyCar Series driver championship in 2004, was second in 2005 and third in 2007.
- Kanaan has 13 career IndyCar Series wins (4<sup>th</sup> all-time), has 63 top-five finishes (1<sup>st</sup> all-time), has led 2,487 laps (4<sup>th</sup> all-time) and has led 62 races (3<sup>rd</sup> all-time).
- His IndyCar Series wins have come at: Phoenix ('03, '04), Texas ('04), Nashville ('04), Kansas ('05), Infineon ('05), Milwaukee ('06, '07), Japan ('07), Michigan ('07), Kentucky ('07), Belle Isle ('07) and Richmond ('08).
