Patrick to Start Second at Nashville in Motorola Car

LEBANON, Tenn., (July 11, 2008) – Danica Patrick, driver of the #7 Motorola car, posted a four-lap average speed of 203.335 miles per hour and qualified second today for the Firestone Indy 200 at Nashville Superspeedway.

Danica Patrick, #7 Motorola Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

“The Motorola car was stuck and it was pretty easy, which is what happens when you are starting up front. It is good to start up front here. I don’t think it’s going to be two-wide for long, but it will be for the first couple of laps until everyone settles in. Our goal is to stay up front and have a strong finish.”

Andretti Qualifies oso*fresh Car 11th at Nashville

LEBANON, Tenn. (July 11, 2008) – Marco Andretti qualified the oso*fresh car 11th for Saturday night's running of the Firestone Indy 200 at Nashville Superspeedway. Andretti posted a four-lap average speed of 202.220 miles per hour during the qualifying session.

Prior to the Firestone Indy 200, Andretti will also be one of AGR's co-drivers of the XM Satellite Radio Acura at Saturday's Northeast Grand Prix at Lime Rock Park.

Live coverage of the Firestone Indy 200 will begin at 8 p.m. (EDT) and will be provided by ESPN. The entire IndyCar Series schedule may also be heard live on XM Satellite Radio, XM channel 145, the official home of the IndyCar Series and the "Andretti Green Racing Hour."

Marco Andretti, #26 oso*fresh Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"We're a little disappointed with qualifying. The cooler temperatures gave us a bit too much drag and downforce so that slowed us down a bit. I think the oso*fresh race car is very good, though, and that's what we've been working on. This is a track where position is key, so hopefully we can do something with strategy. I know if the car can get to the front, it can stay there. We've spent the entire time working on the race setup so we should be good."

Tony Kanaan, #11 Team 7-Eleven Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

“We could have gone a little bit faster. The car was really loose coming off of Turn 4 so we may have been a bit too aggressive on the setup. We were at a bit of a disadvantage because we were the first car out in qualifying. That’s the draw you get so you can’t complain. I was so lucky at Richmond to be one of the last guys, so what goes around comes around. I would have liked to have been on the pole today since it is 7-Eleven’s 81st birthday but maybe they’ll settle for a win tomorrow.”
