Moraes made a mistake and Justin and I were right on his tale and I hit Justin and spun. It was unfortunate because it sent us from 12th to 17th. At the end, I was happy to pass (Ryan) Hunter-Reay for 16th. He blocked me and when I got by him, we actually touched just a bit and I got a puncture in my tire, so I was lucky to make it across the line in that position. Our result is not an indication of our speed or our effort, so that is disappointing, but I am so proud of Tyler and this crew for hanging in there in what has been a tough season. They are some of the hardest-working and most professionals I have ever worked with.”

I wish we could have had a better finish because the car was fast, the strategy was good, and Mario was quick.
