

# Safety Trucks

Since the inception of the Indy Racing League, the Delphi Safety Team has been present for every IndyCar Series and Indy Pro Series event. Traveling 15 members to every IndyCar Series and Indy Pro Series event, the team develops a strong relationship and knowledge of the league's drivers.

## Team

45 safety personnel – 15 of whom attend each event (3 paramedics, 9 firefighters/EMTs, 2 trauma doctors, 1 safety coordinator). Team members have an average of 20 years experience.

## VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT

### COMMAND

- 1 Honda Pilot SUV
- All are equipped with Delphi electronics (Dashboard warning light system, 2 video cameras)
- Command 1 is also equipped with a wireless network laptop computer, visor-mounted TV monitors, XM satellite radio and a satellite TV receiver.



### SAFETY TRUCKS 1, 2 & 3

- 3 Honda Ridgeline trucks designated as Safety 1, 2 and 3.
- All are equipped with Delphi electronics (Dashboard warning light system, 2 video cameras)
- All four trucks carry life-saving medical equipment
- Safety 1 & 2 are outfitted with Holmatro hydraulic rescue tools, DeWalt 24-volt reciprocating saws, firefighting equipment and materials for fluid cleanup.
- Safety 3 has oil dry spreading, brooming and blowing capabilities.
