SONOMA, Calif. (Aug. 24, 2008) – Formula Dream driver Hideki Mutoh finished 13th at Sunday's running of the PEAK Antifreeze & Motor Oil Indy Grand Prix.

Helio Castroneves captured his first win of the season. He was followed by Ryan Briscoe, Team 7-Eleven driver Tony Kanaan, Dan Wheldon and Motorola driver Danica Patrick.

The IndyCar Series returns to action on Aug. 31, with the Detroit Indy Grand Prix at Belle Isle Raceway. ABC will provide live broadcast coverage of the event beginning at 3:30 p.m. (EDT). The race will also be heard on XM Satellite Radio, channel 145, the official home of the IndyCar Series.

Hideki Mutoh, #27 Formula Dream Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"Today was a tough day for the Formula Dream team. Our strategy was to pit in the beginning of the race assuming that all other teams would pit later than us, and to move up when there's less traffic. However, it didn't work out the way we wanted since there were always other teams pitting on the same timing. If strategy worked out well, I think could've finished in the top six but that's the race - you never know if your strategy work or not. I hope I will be able to do better in the next race."

Helio Castroneves drove to the victory, his first of the season. He was followed by Ryan Briscoe. Kanaan, Dan Wheldon and Motorola driver Danica Patrick rounded out the top five.

The IndyCar Series season continues with the Detroit Indy Grand Prix on Sunday, Aug. 31. Kanaan won the inaugural IndyCar Series event at the Raceway at Belle Isle in 2007. Live broadcast coverage of the event will be provided by ABC Sports beginning at 3:30 p.m. (EDT). The race will also be heard on XM Satellite Radio, channel 145, the official home of the IndyCar Series.

Tony Kanaan, #11 Team 7-Eleven Dallara/Honda/Firestone:

"Helio (Castroneves) was just very good today. It was great to put the Team 7-Eleven car on the podium, and I'm not taking it for granted, but I did not have a lot of fun out there today. I didn't enjoy saving fuel from the very first lap, but that's what today's race was all about."
